Tour	The location we are going to is a new training center for Xcel energy line workers, and firefighters. We will have the opportunity to see the training facility, and hear from the Director of Emergency Response as well as the Director of the Trouble Response Organization. I have listed some of the questions we would like them to address below in red.  Highlights of the training facility include:  Transmission Substation Simulator Rows of full-size electric poles indoors for year round training and outdoor poles with transformers A section of naked poles (no wires or other equipment) to train workers to build the structures Rows of switch boxes and transformers like those used in neighborhoods Gas training and gas appliance repair classrooms A village of small buildings that trains gas workers to find and fix leaks both inside and out
