Captain Randy McAlister has been working in the emergency services since 1990 as an EMT, Nationally Registered paramedic, and a police officer. He also served for 14 years on the Washington County SWAT team and retired from the team in 2013 as a Team Commander. Randy has received advanced training in workplace violence prevention, stalking, domestic homicide prevention, school violence and terrorism.
