- April: Aviation Training: The MN National Guard's Aviation assets (Helicopters: Blackhawks & Chinooks) will conduct training with DNR to recertify with wildfires fights. This is mainly for the water buckets and maneuvering safely around the impacted fire areas.
- 07-11 April: The MN National Guard's Joint Operations Center (JOC) will be conducting exercises with Federal agencies at Camp Ripley, MN.
